COVID-19 EVENT SAFETY

To protect yourself and other conference attendees from infection by COVID-19 or other contagious illness, please follow the following safety procedures while attending the conference:



Mask Wearing

Mask-wearing is not mandated for this conference, but is supported as a choice for individual protection. High quality masks are available at the concierge desk in the Pavilion Hall Foyer if you have need.

Reserved seating will be available in Pavilion Hall for individuals choosing to wear masks for their personal protection. Look for signage on designated tables or ask at the concierge desk for directions.



Symptoms

Tissues and hand sanitizer are located at tables throughout the event space. Please cover your mouth if sneezing or coughing for any reason.

Common COVID-19 symptoms are fever and chills, cough, new loss of taste or smell, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea.

Anyone developing symptoms during the conference should immediately put on a mask and depart for home to take care and feel better soon.
